1<sup>st</sup> Roberts' Kanix Dante's Inferno. He stood out in this class. Masculine, proud and well balanced. Moved with drive and purpose, he had muscle.

2<sup>nd</sup> Best's Shadesett Keep on Believin for Bestina. Another superb dog. There was little between these two dogs. Well balanced. Moved well but didn't have the drive of the winner.

### **MINOR PUPPY DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Roberts' Fanmatrix Midnight's Dream. This class was very even, they all needed time to settle and mature. Once he settled he really showed well and moved well. Would like to see this boy in 12 months time. Head and eyes nice, a balanced body. Used his tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> Chevalier's Victory Salute to Roughpoint. Handsome chap, not as settled as winner. He acted his age, but a nice outline.

3<sup>rd</sup> Goodall's Fydal Chandon.

### **PUPPY DOG (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Roberts' Fanmatrix Roll Tiger Roll. He soon settled. Nice head. Good rib. Sound on movement. A pleasing puppy.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilkinson's Stocksfell Humdinger. This puppy never settled. Erratic on movement. He was not easy to judge.

### **JUNIOR DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Sniperay Lord Lambourne via Tzatziki. A super boy. Looks naughty but he has a good outline. Super head and expression. Well let down shoulders. Level topline. Moved well slashing his tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> Mason's Nosam Secret Agent. Another super boy. Overall well balanced. Moved well, happy boy.

### **YEARLING DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Roberts' Kanix Othello. This boy as matured since the last time I saw him. Good head, eye and reach of neck. Super outline. Moved well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Saunders' Phynnies Princes of Thieves JW. Was not as mature as winner, but is a nice shape. Needs time on movement.

3<sup>rd</sup> Cooper-Pearson's Keepersfield Chevalier.

### **NOVICE DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Mason's Nosam Secret Agent.

2<sup>nd</sup> Cooper-Pearson's Keepersfield Chevalier. Super dog. Well balanced. Correct size. Unsteady on movement.

3<sup>rd</sup> Goodall's Fydal Chandon.

### **GRADUATE DOG (5,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Wall's Meadowpoint Spirit of Fire. Never seen this boy before, but he stood out in this class. Cracking dog. Well balanced. Moved with drive and well muscled. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince for Tomlow. This was such a very strong class but only one red rosette. Another fantastic dog, well balanced and mature. Moved with drive, super dog.

Pretty bitch, flashy, sound construction. Moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Lake's Wild Thyme.

### **NOVICE BITCH (10)**
