MINOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1st Walkling's Wilchrimane Tambuti with Kiswahili. 7 mths with a very pleasing head and eye, well constructed and an excellent body for his age, lovely outline, strong loin and very good hindquarters, move well with lots of confidence.

2nd Gordon & Howarth's Hawkfield Jolly. 6 mths, very good head and eye, elegant with a very good outline, well constructed throughout, not as positive in hind action as the winner.

PUPPY DOG (1)

1st Osman's Fleurfield Hidden Depths via Marissolo. 9 mths, good head and eye, good forehand and good depth of chest, strong topline and good tail set, well angulated front and rear, just needs to develop, moved soundly but could be stronger behind.

JUNIOR DOG (7, 1)

1st Wilcox's Pipeaway Dreams Afyre in Merynjen. Super head and eye, excellent body and construction, well knit together throughout, lovely outline with a strong topline, a very good tail and set on, strong, well angulated hindquarters, sound, free, accurate mover.

2nd Lowe's Lowsmoor Crazy For You. Upstanding with a good outline, well constructed with very good body properties, well let down in chest, strong topline and good tail set, strong topline and good tail set, strong hindquarters, sound free mover.

3rd Tregaskis' Moenfair Sanguineum Luna.

YEARLING DOG (8)

1st Scholes' Wilchrimane Tea For Two with Rossgilde JW. Very good breed type, excellent head and eye, well constructed body, good bone and feet, very good depth of chest, very good outline, strong short coupled loin and strong well angulated hindquarters, sound active mover, scoring in rear action, good tail carriage, and action on the move.

2nd Wilcox's Pipeaway Dreams Afyre in Merynjen.

3rd Lowe's Lowsmoor Crazy For You.

POST GRADUATE DOG (15, 3)

1st Preece & Gilding's Harvestslade Cullinan. Very good head and eye, well constructed and balanced throughout, lovely outline, strong topline and good tail set, short, strong loin and strong well angulated hindquarters, well knit together with excellent front, bone and feet, and very good body properties, moved very soundly with good carriage, excelled in front and rear pasterns. Res DCC.

2nd Flint's Casilex Cognac. Excellent head and eye, very good breed type, lovely outline, good front assembly and good depth and width of chest, very good body properties and well angulated hindquarters, sound mover.

3rd O'Neill's Tenshilling Biscuits JW.

LIMIT DOG (7, 1)

1st Philo's Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist JW ShCM. Very good breed type, has elegance and substance, well constructed throughout, lovely outline, strong topline and good tail set, strong well muscled hindquarters, short coupled loin, very active sound mover with very good tail action.

2nd Gordon's Hawkfield Audacity JW (AI). An excellent head and eye, well constructed with a pleasing outline, strong topline and good tail set, good body properties, longer cast than winner, strong hindquarters, sound movement.

3rd Martin's Sunhouse Chips Ahoy.

OPEN DOG (4, 1)

1st O'Neill's Sh Ch Chesterhope Thrill Of Tchase (Imp NZ). Upstanding with an excellent head and eye, beautiful outline, so well constructed throughout, excellent depth and width of chest, super body properties with a strong, short coupled loin, strong, sweeping hindquarters with good turn of hock and strong, short rear pasterns, effortless ground covering stride, super carriage and deportment and very good tail action.

2nd O'Neill's Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone JW ShCM. Another top class dog, excellent breed type, super head and eye, very well constructed, lovely forehand, well balanced throughout, lovely outline, strong, short loin, sound free mover, not the carriage of the winner today.

3rd Roberts' Kanix Othello.

VETERAN DOG (2)

1st Welch's Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood JW ShCM. 9 yrs with a very good head and eye, upstanding with a lovely outline, strong topline and good tail set, well balanced with good body, good depth and width of chest, strong loin and strong well angulated hindquarters, very sound active mover.

2nd Roberts' Kanix Dante's Inferno. Very good head and eye, well balanced and constructed throughout, very good depth of chest, strong topline and good tail set, carrying a little too much weight today, good bee sting tail, a sound mover but lacked the animation of winner.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5, 1)

1st Gerrard's Chesterhope C'mon Over to Carmandine (Imp NZ). Lovely bitch with a beautiful head and eye, lovely outline, so well balanced, excellent construction throughout, in fact, excellent in all departments. Front, bone and feet, topline and tail set, strong sweeping hindquarters, super mover. One to watch. BPIB.

2nd Clinton's Hawkfield Merry. 6 mths, lovely head and eye, upstanding with a very good forehand, well constructed throughout, everything in the right place, just needs to develop in body, super mover with a lovely carriage.

3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Happy.

PUPPY BITCH (3)

1st Rose's Ridanflight Ramble. Very pleasing head and eye, well constructed with a lovely outline, excellent body properties, good rib and strong loin, strong hindquarters, well let down in hock, moved well with good carriage and tail action.

2nd Welch's Hookwood Cupid. Typical head, very well constructed and balanced throughout, very good front, bone and feet and good body properties, strong, short loin, strong well muscled hindquarters, moved soundly.

3rd Clinton's Hawkfield Merry.

JUNIOR BITCH (8 2)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Sound Wave. Lovely head and eye, well constructed with excellent balance throughout, quality bone and good feet, lovely outline with a strong topline and good tail set, strong sweeping hindquarters with very good width of thigh, lovely tail which she used to advantage when moving, sound, free mover with good carriage.

2nd Whitehead's Joneva Esmeralda of Stridview. Beautiful head and eye, lovely outline with super body properties, excellent depth and width of chest, so well constructed throughout, strong sweeping hindquarters, so feminine but has correct body and substance, very sound mover. It was unfortunate her handler had a very bad fall in the ring, which rather unsettled her.

3rd Lowe's Lowsmoor Half A Sixpence.

YEARLING BITCH (7, 2)

1st Hinton's Fleurfield Morning Glory. Very good head and eye, upstanding with a good forehand, pleasing outline with a strong topline and good tail set, good depth of chest, short coupled loin, strong, well angulated hindquarters, moved well.

2nd Lowe's Lowsmoor Half A Sixpence. Another quality bitch placed in the strong junior class. Good head and eye, very good outline, well constructed throughout, sound, free mover but could have more width in hind action.

3rd Welch, Maber & Hazeltine's Sharnphilly Toggi with Hookwood JW.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (5, 2)

1st Preece & Gilding's Harvestslade Lesedi La Rona. Very good head and eye, well constructed with a pleasing outline, very good body properties, good forehand, front, bone and feet, strong topline and good tail set, strong loin, in hard muscular condition, well angulated hindquarters, animated mover but could be more accurate in front action.

2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Gartarry All That Jazz at Spinray. Lovely head and eye, very good outline, well constructed with good flow over shoulders, good body and well angulated hindquarters, preferred the overall movement of winner.

3rd Stokes' Hawkfield Castaspell over Guanabara JW.

LIMIT BITCH (9, 3)

1st Blackburn-Bennett & Macara's Kanix Naughty Nancy. Upstanding with a lovely head and eye, super outline, very well balanced and constructed throughout, excellent front assembly, strong, short coupled loin, super hindquarters, powerful, assertive mover, scoring heavily in hind action. Res BCC.

2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Gartarry High Society at Spinray JW. A very good head and eye, good outline, strong topline and good tail set, well constructed and balanced throughout, in hard muscular condition, moved very soundly with good tail action.

3rd O'Neill's Fyldefair Sky Full Of Stars over Tenshilling.

OPEN BITCH (8, 2)

1st Hazeltine's Am Ch Bookstor Fabello Kinky Boots. Caught my eye immediately she entered the ring. So feminine with a lovely head and eye, very well balanced with no exaggeration, so well constructed and knit together in body, strong, short coupled loin, well muscled and angulated hindquarters, a lovely outline with a very good tail, well set on completed the picture. A very sound animated mover. BCC.

2nd Blackburn-Bennett & Macara's Kanix Petunia at Stargang. Upstanding bitch with a very good head and eye, well constructed throughout, strong topline and good tail set, excellent body and strong well muscled hindquarters, moved soundly.

3rd Harrison's Millpoint Hopes N'Dreams JW ShCM.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

1st O'Neill's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas JW. 9 yrs, lovely breed type, beautiful head and eye, well constructed with very good body properties, lovely outline and strong hindquarters, still a sound active mover with good carriage.

2nd Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar. Also very pleasing breed type, very good head and eye, good outline, well constructed with strong hindquarters, moved well, in lovely show bloom.
