1<sup>st</sup> Walking's Wilchrimane Tambuti with Kiswahili. O/W 10 month old with pleasing head into a strong neck. Deep chest and brisket with a lovely level topline, good rear angulation which allowed him to move well. BP

2<sup>nd</sup> Welch's Sweet Dreams by Hookwood. B/W 8 month old with a lovely outline and pleasing feature. He didn't like the floor so was unsettled but his strong head and overall outline gained him 2<sup>nd</sup> in the class. 3<sup>rd</sup> Matthews' Sonham Remember Me

#### **JUNIOR DOG (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Saguineum Luna. L/W, nice head with a good reach of neck into a longer cast body and level topline. Moved ok with tail lashing.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Here I Go Again. B/W youngster with a nice head and level topline and pleasing body. Good chest and overall outline, needs time to settle and mature.

## **POST GRADUATE DOG** (7, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Ovel's Jimaura Bandido. B/W who was the best mover in the class, he had a nice head with a deep brisket and good rear angulation.

2<sup>nd</sup> Roberts' Fanmatrix Midnight's Dream. B/W nice head and long neck, longer cast with level topline and good rear angulation, lost out to 1 on movement.

3<sup>rd</sup> Cooper & Pearson's Keepersfield Chevalier

#### **OPEN DOG** (10, 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoogle JW. B/W lovely male who is lovely both on the move and stood. He has a lovely head leading into well set shoulders and deep brisket with a level topline. Long loin into lovely rear angulation. Best mover of the day and delighted to award BD and BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wall's Meadowpoint Spirit of Fire. B/W dog who again has a lovely head and good body, well-muscled, level topline and good angulation. Another strong mover, RBD.

#### **SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Ovel's Jimaura Bandido.

2<sup>nd</sup> Booth's Lundgarth Finch. O/W pleasing head with good reach of neck into a longer cast, moved well.

## **PUPPY BITCH (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Brooksmith's Nightgold Pipkin. 6 month L/W Pretty bitch with a good front and body into strong rear angulation and a level topline. Good mover for age and won BPB.

 $2^{nd}$  Matthews' Sonham Chasing Rainbows. 6 month b/w bitch with a pretty head and expression, leading into a long neck and a lovely overall outline with good angulation. Just needs time to settle.

## **JUNIOR BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Welch's Hookwood Cupid. B/W finer bitch which a long reach of neck into a level topline and strong underline. Good rear angulation and length of body but needs time to settle on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Webster & Goodwin's Millpoint Air Wave. Another pretty bitch with a long reach of neck into good length of body and rear angulation.

#### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (13, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Watkins, Phillips & Gordon's Hawkfield Audacious (AI) JW. O/W Longer cast bitch with nice head and pronounced front angulation. Good rear angulation and level topline. Won this class on movement on the day.

2<sup>nd</sup> Maude's Hawkfield Ouija Board. L/W bitch with a good front and pretty head and level topline, moved ok.

3<sup>rd</sup> Chevalier's Millpoint Some Like It Hot

**OPEN BITCH** (11). This was the strongest class of the day, and certainly one and two could change places on another day.

1<sup>st</sup> Cobden's Hawkfield Bronze for Alozia ShCM. L/W lovely typical pointer bitch, she has a pretty head leading into a good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. She has a good body and level topline, with great drive and purpose on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Oddie, Dyer & Coles's SH CH Sharnphilly Serendipity JW. Another bitch which oozes quality and litter sister to BOB. Strong outline and well-muscled, just preferred the drive of 1 on the day.

3<sup>rd</sup> Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Gartarry High Society at Spinray JW
